Professor M.N. Srinivas Memorial Prize 2019

The Indian Sociological Society invites submission of paper/s or book chapter/s (**not more than two**) written in English for consideration for the award of the Professor M.N. Srinivas Memorial Prize for the year 2019. The Prize carries a cash award of Rs. 2500 and would be conferred at the 45th All India Sociological Conference to be held at Thiruvananthapuram, December 27 to 29, 2019.

The conditions for submission are as follows:

- Publication/s submitted must be sociological/social anthropological papers or book chapters published in any social science journal/edited volume.
- The journal/edited volume must have been published between January 01, 2017 and December 31, 2018.
- The author/s must be 40 years of age or less as on December 31, 2018. Proof of age has to be produced. In the case of a joint publication age proof must be produced for both the authors.
- The author must be a Life Member or Ordinary Member of Indian Sociological Society of at least one year's standing. The ISS Membership Number and the year of taking membership must be mentioned in the covering letter to be submitted along with the publication/s.
- A photocopy of the paper/s or book chapter/s (**not more than two**) may be submitted along with the photocopies of the title page and list of contents of the journal/edited volume to Ms. Boinu Vaiphei, Office Secretary, Indian Sociological Society, Flat Number 1046, Sector C-Pocket 1, Vasant Kunj, New Delhi 110070 on or before October 31, 2018. Typewritten/hand written/computer print-outs/manuscripts will not be accepted.
- Paper/s or book chapters co-authored may have a maximum of two authors only.
- In the event of a paper/s or book chapter/s being a joint publication, the award is given only to the younger author, whether a student or otherwise. The younger author may be the 'author for correspondence'.
- AC III railway fare to and from the place of residence to the conference site would be paid for the awardee receiving the Prize.
- Nominations are also welcome.
