President's Message

These are days of paradoxes. The world society has entered an age of disenchantment with globalisation despite the continuity of pursuit of market oriented policies and programmes by various nation-states across the globe. We hear debates about the need to go for sustainable development. The rise in inequalities since 1990s or 'the Fall of Berlin Wall' is a global cry. From Wall Street in the US to Taharir Square in Egypt, there was a wave of discontent about the increasing crisis of participation in the affairs of economy, society and governance due to increasing marginalisation of common people. The issue of chronic poverty is repeatedly underlined in policy studies and program evaluations. There is complaint about exclusivity in the market mediated liberalisation. There is protest about the exceptionalism of the G-8 countries in the affairs of the modern world system. But there is no innovative effort on the part of the alternative alliance of the BRICS countries. The momentum generated by the processes like World Social Forum is on the decline. India is no exception. Indian society seems to have become demystified about the process of industry driven development as evident from the rise of a ring of resistances from Odisha to Tamilnadu and West Bengal to western Uttar Pradesh. It is not difficult to hear loud voices of clear 'no' to the pet projects of the corporate world like big dams, mega cities, international trade, and no concern for the labour standards. There is growing belief that the LPG model of development is

responsible for breeding crony capitalism which contains the worst features of capitalism (greed in society and exploitation of productive forces) and welfare states (bureaucratic control and corruption at high places) at the same time. Commercialisation and corporatisation are twin processes which have been at the root of growing discontent against the UPA II regime. But it is not reflected in the discourse of power at the institutional level in the elections and media. There is great partnership between the middle classes, media houses and corporate groups to promote market based policies in the name of 'development'. So no one was surprised that the elections of 2014 have established a clear majority based government at the Centre which is clearly committed for fast track implementation of all the dream projects of the LPG supporters with a strong leader, single party majority in parliament and sidelining the promises of participatory democracy and rights for health, food and shelter to all. There is clear disconnect between the power elite and people in the global and national affairs. At the same time, the efforts to gain legitimacy through politics of economic nationalism in the world affairs and majoritarian cultural identity in the national affairs are getting approval from the masses through the democratic methods. It is strange but true. It is paradoxical and persisting phenomenon at the present. We need to explore it further and deeper for remaining relevant as science of society in both its manifestations - social order and social change.
