

About the B. N. Mandal University, Madhepura

B. N. Mandal University, Madhepura came into existence on the 10th of January, 1992 after its bifurcation from L. N. Mithila University, Darbhanga under the statutory provision of the Act of Bihar in the rural, socioeconomic backward and badly ruined area surrounded by the river Koshi of the north eastern Bihar, with an aim to impart higher education to the deprived section as the main population of this area. The University was registered under 2(F) of the UGC act 1956 vide office memo dated 26th May, 1993 and granted recognition under section 12(B) of the UGC act 1956 vide office memo no9-3/929 (CPP-I) dated 19th Oct., 2004 as notified by the University Memo No. G.S.1166/04 dated 31/10/2004. B. N. Mandal University, Madhepura offering Undergraduate, Post-Graduate and Doctoral programs in various disciplines of Science, Social Science, Humanities, Commerce and Education.

This University has two campuses namely, South Campus and North Campus. South Campus is the administrative campus. All the administrative offices are located in this campus. There is a big central library and an auditorium in this campus. The north campus is a purely academic campus and all the post graduate departments are located there. B. N. Mandal comprises of 13 constituent colleges, 32 affiliated college including B.Ed. colleges spread across Koshi Division.

Nearby Places

Singheshwar Temple:

Singheshwar Asthan is located eight kilometers from Dauram Madhepura (N.E. Railway), which is the headquarters of the same-named block. The hamlet is known for an old Shiva temple, which is located around 7 kilometers north. The Shiva lingam in the Singheshwar Asthan temple was built by Sringa Rishi, according to tradition. Shring Rishi was the one who conducted the Putrayeshti Yajna for King Dasharath, and he was later blessed with four sons as a result. The influence of this mythology may be observed in the high number of childless ladies who come to conduct puja here on a daily basis. On the festival of Shivaratri, a month-long fair is conducted, which is one of the largest in the state.

Nayanagar Durga Sthan:

Nayanagar Durga Sthan, located 11 kilometers from Gwalpara Block HQ and 35 kilometers from Madhepura Distt. HQ, is known not just for Manokamna Siddhi in Mahdepura but also in the surrounding regions. For the completion of their Manokamna, the devotees make a flower and Bipatra gift to Goddess Durga. It is often believed that whomever makes a gift to Goddess has his manokamna fulfilled.

Dakini Sthan:

Dakini Sthan is located 5 kilometers from the Alamnagar Block HQ and 60 kilometers from the Madhepura Distt. HQ.
