

Guidelines for the Authors:

The journal, for submission, encourages data based (both primary and secondary) quality research papers using sociological concepts and theories in the analysis. It is open to both quantitative as well as qualitative exercises in sociology. Besides, regular research papers, book reviews and brief recommendations of major national and international seminars/ conferences with academic and serious policy implications would be a regular feature of the journal. Even the journal provides for a **Discussants' Corner** for scholarly debates.

The ideal length of the paper should be between 8000 to 10,000 words. The citations and referencing should follow the format of the American Psychological Association. All the references making a section is to appear at the end and must be complete in every sense (including name/s of the author/s, editor/s, documents, edition, publisher, place and year of publication, and exact page numbers, etc).

All the papers should be communicated in MS word (doc) file as well as PDF file. It should be accompanied by a signed declaration by the author/s that the paper has not been communicated (or would not be up-till under the consideration of this journal) elsewhere for publication.

Only selected notes should be presented as **End Notes** immediately before the reference section. Tables & graphs, should appear in the text in their appropriate places. Pictures/photos, figures, etc should be attached in a separate file/s. Citations and quotations used by the author/s are subject to the prevalent international norms of copyright and plagiarism.

Each paper must be accompanied by an abstract (around 150 words) and at least five key words indicating the central theme of the paper.
