As we approach the upcoming elections, we want to ensure a seamless online voting process for all our esteemed members.

Please follow the instructions below to cast your vote effectively:

- 1. Open the Indian Sociological Society Website in your web browser and click on Login to cast your vote OR go to https://indian-sociological-society.web.app/login.
- 2. Enter your 4-digit LMI in the provided text box. If it is less than 4 digits, prefix '0's (e.g., for LMI 99, enter 0099; for LMI 199, enter 0199).
- 3. Click on the 'Request OTP' button. A 6-digit OTP will be sent to your registered Email ID.
- 4. Check your email for the OTP and enter the 6-digit code. (If you do not find an email for OTP then please do check your spam or Junk folder.)
- 5. Click on the 'Verify OTP' button.
- 6. After successful login, you will be redirected to the actual voting site.
- 7. The voting session will automatically end after 10 minutes, so please ensure you submit your vote within this timeframe.
- 8. If the session ends before your vote submission, repeat the login process.
- 9. On the voting web page, vote for one candidate for the President, one candidate for the Secretary, and up to five candidates for the Managing Committee.
- 10. You have the option to choose N.O.T.A. if needed.
- 11. Click on the 'Submit Vote' button.
- 12. A pop-up window will appear to confirm your selections.
- 13. Click on 'Cancel' if you wish to change your vote selection.
- 14. Click the 'Yes, submit vote' button for the final submission. (After clicking "Yes, Submit Vote" button you won't be able to change your selections.)
- 15. A confirmation message will be displayed upon the successful submission of your vote.
