Prof. (Dr) Bibhuti Bhushan Malik is a Professor and former Dean, Ambedkar School of Social Sciences at Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar University (BBAU) Lucknow holding several key positions, including the Chief Proctor and Professor in Charge of the University Works Department. Previously, he worked in Mahatma Gandhi Kashi Vidyapeeth Varanasi, National Institute of Social Work and Social Sciences, Bhubaneswar and Dayalbagh Educational Institutions, Agra. The craft of his learning Sociology received its best expurgated throughout but especially at the helm of Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi, under the famous mentors of the highest order under Prof. Yogendra Singh's tutelage, who served as both supervisor and mentor to foster quality teaching and research. Meanwhile, he published numerous articles/papers in national and international journals and contributed to chapters in edited volumes. He is actively engaged in academic affairs of ICSSR and UGC as a subject expert and member of the NAAC. He also served as an external member of various states and central universities' Research Advisory Committees (RAC), Board of Post Graduate Studies (BPGS), and Departmental Research Committees (DRC), contributing actively to the enrichment of syllabus, course materials and research activities. His persistent and genuine attempt has been to empirically and theoretically advance the discipline of sociology and the Indian Sociological Society.

I have been teaching at Tezpur University (TU), Assam since 1997 where I became a professor in 2010. Prior to that, I did my M.A., M.Phil., and Ph.D. from University of Delhi. Since the beginning of my teaching career, I have been engaged in institution building. As the founder Head of the Department of Sociology at TU, I helped the department grow into a vibrant and cosmopolitan centre for teaching and research. I have made some contributions to the steady expansion of the discipline in the higher educational institutions (HEI) in Assam. Before that, I played a leading role in giving shape to the Dept. of Cultural Studies at TU. Between 1918-2023, I headed the incipient Department of Social Work at TU and helped establish the department as an attractive destination for students. I have also served on various important administrative and academic committees at TU. Besides, I have been part of important bodies of several HEIs including Tata Institute of Social Science (TISS), Guwahati campus; Cotton University; LGB Regional Institute of Mental Health; etc. Apart from being on the Board of Studies of several universities, I have also served in various important bodies of several Mest Bengal. I have also served in various important bodies of the Government of Assam, ICSSR, and UGC.

I have been a visiting fellow to several universities that include Queen's University, Belfast (as Charles Wallace Trust Visiting Fellow, 2008), University of Delhi (2014), and Centre for the Study of Social Systems, Jawaharlal Nehru University (2015). I was awarded the ICCR Chair Professor Abroad in 2015 but could not accept on account of pressing institutional responsibilities.

I have an abiding engagement with various pressing socio-political issues and civil society movements in the northeastern region and have written and commented extensively on them both in regional and national media. I have published several books and monographs which include *Culture Studies: Themes and Perspectives* (ed. Tezpur University, 2003), *Fixed Borders, Fluid Boundaries: Identity Resources and Mobility in Northeast India* (ed. Routledge, 2020), and *Coronasphere: Narratives on COVID 19 from India and its Neighbours.* (ed. Routledge, 2022). I have published in journals like *EPW*, *Sociological Bulletin, Postcolonial Studies, Asian Ethnicity*, and so on.

I was the Organizing Secretary of the 42<sup>nd</sup> AISC organized at TU in 2016 which was appreciated by all for as one of the most professionally organized conferences. During 2017-2021, I served as the founder editor of *Explorations*: the e-journal of the Indian Sociological Society. Within my tenure, the journal became a prominent forum for publishing sociological research in India. Besides serving on the editorial board of several journals, I have been a reviewer for many reputed journals and publishers.
