

Dr. Saket Bihari is working as an Associate Professor at Indian Institute of Public Administration, New Delhi, an autonomous body under the Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT), Government of India. He has completed his MA, M.Phil., and PhD from the Centre for the Study of Social Systems, School of Social Sciences, Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi.

He has supervised 20 candidates for the M.Phil. and co-supervised 3 candidates for PhD programmes. His extensive expertise is in research methodology, sociology of education, cultural studies, globalization, and social stratification.

He has 25 years of teaching and research experience. His research interests span from social development to women's studies to rural and urban sociology to anthropological theories to methodological innovations—perfectly resonating with the subjects' focus through interdisciplinary approaches. He has written eight books and 37 research papers. He also writes periodically in "Business World" and reviews various reports and theme papers on contemporary issues. Bestowed twice with the TN Chaturvedi Memorial Award for conducting the maximum number of studies, Dr. Bihari is invited by government departments and ministries to contribute to the effectiveness of different public policies. He also traces sociological insights from the Indian Knowledge System (IKS) by emphasising fourteen sources of knowledge.
