About Conference

Contemporary Bihar: Beyond Stereotypes (A Multidisciplinary Analysis of Socio-Cultural Milieu of Bihar)

Bihar attained statehood on March 22, 1912. The attainment of statehood was the outcome of a strong yearning among the elites and the commoners to carve out a distinct identity within the map of India. The sense of identity had its historical roots as Magadha was once the most prominent Mahajanpada of ancient India. Biharis contribute to nation building by their sheer hard work, grit, determination, enterprise and intellect in civil services and other sectors. Bihari students are present in sizable numbers in classrooms of the leading institutions which choose either on the basis of merit or hefty payment or both.

Presently, Bihar is taking strides in the direction of creating an inclusive environment for the marginalized sections, in general. Women empowerment is being ensured through several initiatives such as 35 per cent reservation for women in government jobs since 2016. Its impact is readily visible in the police force where presence of women personnel is highest in the country as per Bureau of Police Research and Development data of 2023. Bihar became the first state to ensure equal participation of women in self governance by introducing 50 per cent reservation in the local bodies in 2006. Amenities for the common man are improving as road connectivity and electricity reaches every nook and corner of this third largest state in terms of population (13.28 Crores approximately in 2024) and 12th largest state area wise. Bihar led the nation in successfully conducting the Caste Census in 2023.

The third Conference of Bihar Sociological society intends to unravel the many facets of Bihari society. The conference theme intends to challenge the prevailing stereotypical assumptions about the society and culture of Bihar. It would encourage research and studies in regional sociology as its theme dwells on dispelling the myths regarding Bihar. We indeed intend to highlight the societal and cultural attributes of the land of Angika, Bhojpuri, Magahi, Maithili and Vajjika, besides many local dialects, each having its own distinctive socio-cultural features.
